Dear Mrs. Gough,

I have made enquiries about the Fencing entrants and understand that your son applied at the Salle and was, therefore, refused entry by an official there, and not by any member of Park House. This refusal was probably made on the grounds that your son is no longer at school, as I understand ^{that} all entrants for the Schools' Fencing Championships must be a pupil at school — as well as under 18 years of age. Perhaps your son mixed up the conditions with those required for the Killanin Cup which also stipulate that entrants must be under 18, but do not, I understand, require attendance at school.

I have passed your letter on to Maitre Duffy, and suggest that if you wish to pursue the matter you should get in touch with him.
