Dear Mr. Gough,

I am directed by the Council to inform you that it has decided to suspend your membership and withdraw your licence until 31st August, 1967, as a result of your conduct in connection with the recent Schoolboys' Championships.

I quote hereunder the relevant Section of the Constitution of the Irish Amateur Fencing Federation:-

Article 8, Section (i)

"The Council shall by a two-third majority of the members voting have power to reprimand, suspend or expel any member whose conduct it deems detrimental to the interests or the character of the Federation."

Article 8, Section (iii)

"If requested within ten days by the member to be disciplined, or by three members of the Council, a Committee of not less than five fencing members of the Federation shall be appointed by the President to investigate the conduct charged against the member. The Committee shall give the member an opportunity to be heard on the matters before it. The Council shall not exercise its disciplinary powers unless the Committee confirms the charges made to have been proved."
